DESCRIPTION

This project contributes to the investment programmes in the water and sanitation sector by two of the main service providers in the country: the National Institute of Drinking Water and Sewerage (INAPA), active in rural and peri-urban areas, and the Corporation of Water and Sewerage of Santiago (CORAASAN), active in the city and in the province of Santiago, reinforcing their efficiency and sustainability at the same time. The Program includes investments in water and sanitation infrastructure, capacity building and technical support to ensure quality, efficiency, and sustainability of services.

OBJECTIVE:

The Program aims to increase the efficiency of water services, reduce wastewater discharges into the environment and improve the technical and financial sustainability of INAPA and CORAASAN.

EXPECTED RESULTS:

- Wider coverage and continuity of service without increasing water production
- Reduced discharge of wastewater and pollution
- Network rehabilitation and reduced leaks
- Positive impact on public health, poverty reduction and climate change adaptation
